District Financing Update:

On October 5, 2018, the District was approved by Colorado Water Resources & Power Development Authority (CWRPDA) for a \$3 million loan at 0% interest to improve the District's Water System. TZA Water Engineers and ORC Water Professionals have been working diligently on creating a list of priorities, and work is tentatively scheduled to begin in Spring 2019. Please attend the upcoming Board Meetings on November 26th and December 19th to hear the planned list of improvements and to give your input.

Rate Increase:

The District is required by CWRPDA to have a 3 month operational reserve, which is also good business. In order to meet this requirement and cover increased operating expenses, the Board will consider adopting a resolution to increase fees, rates, tolls and charges, including the Availability of Service Fee at the regular meeting in November. If adopted, the proposed rate increase will go into effect beginning in January 2019.

Did you Know?:

The District is comprised of approximately 310 customers who are connected to the water and sanitation system and 420 who are assessed the availability of service fee. In order for the District to maintain its current system, and make needed repairs, it is crucial that all customers are paying their bills on time. The District has developed a long-term plan with specific goals in mind: assessing rates that cover the cost of operations, addressing the District's lack of reserves and making necessary improvements to the systems. These goals are achievable if we all continue to move forward and work together!
